### **2024 MAIN PROJECTS**

#### Promoting critical thinking in pre-electoral and electoral context

Period: October 2023 - December 2024

Funded by: the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands

**Budget**: 19.840 EUR **Role**: applicant

**Brief**: The project "Promoting critical thinking in pre-electoral and electoral context" aimed at increasing critical thinking among the general public, media professionals, regulatory bodies and politicians on the importance of fair, free and accountable media in electoral contexts.

#### Main outcomes:

During the project lifespan, ActiveWatch has published and put forward:

- 4 analyses
- 2 policy papers and 1 informative article
- 20 rapid reactions and advocacy actions
- 18 educational materials (infographics and factsheets)

The reports and rapid reactions produced in this project were used as sources of information for our submission to the Rule of Law Report of the European Commission for 2025, that we put forward to the Commission together with Reporters without Borders.

The reports and rapid reactions produced in this project were also used as sources of information for the "Media Capture Monitoring Report: Romania", published by two leading advocacy and research organizations in Europe - the International Press Institute and the Media and Journalism Research Center. The Media Capture Monitoring Report aims at assessing the state of media capture by political interests and the extent to which regulation to protect media independence meets new standards set by the European Media Freedom Act. It is meant to help policy development and implementation at EU level.

Due to our sustained efforts of monitoring the media landscape, and due to our permanent monitoring of, as well as involvement, with the relevant public authorities, AW managed to provide the first assessment of political spending in the media based on public information available at the National Council of Audiovisual.

We analyzed all relevant audiovisual legislation and put forward a legal analysis that was never done before regarding the (i)legality and (un)ethical aspects of payments received by media outlets from political parties for access on prime time TV shows.

Our rapid reactions and advocacy actions were meant at safeguarding a better legislative and institutional framework with impact on the electoral processes.



#### Project "Group of NGOs for Citizens"

Period: January 2024 - December 2024

Funded by: the Network of European Foundation/CIVITATES

**Budget**: 9.660 EUR **Role**: Partner

The project aims to contribute to a healthy electoral campaign, by exposing and preventing antidemocratic and populist back-sliding, and potential attacks, including hate speech, attempts to limit the civic freedoms, scape-goat-ing etc.; encouraging a healthy electoral debate, focused on real issues, rather than on populistic messages; encouraging a better representation of traditionally underrepresented groups. The project also aims to use the electoral campaigns to advocate for the legislative issues on our agenda: right to peaceful assemblies, transparency in decision-making, access to information as well as to open the debate on other issues (such as public safety vs. authoritarianism, involvement of the military in civil affairs). We aim to build a communication campaign to stimulate the citizens' critical attitude towards populism. We also work to strengthen the Coalition's capacity: internal cohesion, members' involvement, improving the return of investment for members, building a community of supporters, strengthening our voice on EU affairs.

# Project "We need to talk about elections - Tools and talks for informed elections and decisions"

Period: March 2024 - March 2025

Funded by: the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands

**Budget:** 14.490 EUR **Role**: applicant

The project aimed to introduce university students to the challenges raised by the electoral campaigns of 2024 and 2025, and to empower these young voters with a set of critical skills and attitudes, helping them to become better informed voters.

#### Outcomes and outputs:

- Over 500 better informed young voters (students from Bucharest, Cluj-Napoca, Oradea, and Timisoara)
- 11 seminars at 9 different universities/faculties
- Networking and know-how exchange with 8 university professors around the country
- Improved understanding of young people political and social concerns, as well as their information needs
- 45 experts and students gathered in a workshop on audience and research, with the participation of international speakers, hosted by the University of Bucharest
- 9 conference lectures published online



#### **Project "Civic Space Grant"**

Period: December 2023 - December 2024

Funded by: IFEX Budget: 20.000 USD Role: applicant

With the IFEX Civic Space Grant support, ActiveWatch was able to sustain its actions aimed at protecting the civic space and the right to FoE&I in Romania, focusing on bringing to light and raising awareness on the negative actions and narratives targeting independent media and non-governmental organisations (NGOs), in an electoral context.


During the project lifespan, ActiveWatch has published and put forward 34 documents:
